

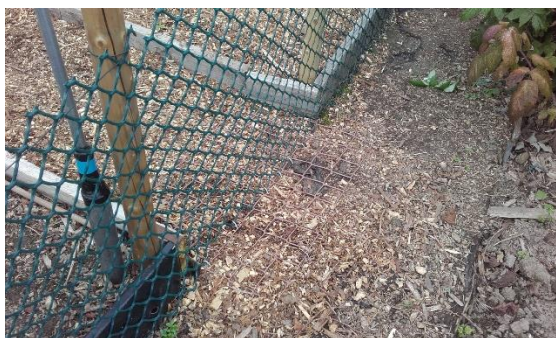
8oz onions (Toughball) pricked out and watered
